

# BRASS

**Adjudicator: Paul Denegri Hon ARAM, FTCL, LTCL**

**Paul Denegri** began his musical career as a Junior Exhibitioner at the Royal College of Music, studying trumpet with Colin Cleague, then moving to Trinity College London where he studied trumpet with Iaan Wilson. At Trinity College Paul was awarded the *I'll Sono di Ottone Prize for Performance* twice in successive years. At the very young age of just 24 Paul was appointed as Head of Brass, Jazz and Commercial Music at Wells Cathedral Specialist Music School where he still remains to this day. Paul is recognised nationally as an outstanding brass coach and works regularly with the country's leading youth ensembles including The National Youth Wind Orchestra, The National Children's Orchestra and The National Youth Wind Ensemble. Paul has been a professor of trumpet for Bristol and Exeter Universities and in 2007 was invited to be the Artistic Director of The South West Music School, where he was asked to advise on its artistic role in its first year of existence. Since then he has maintained a close relationship with the school as a mentor, on the audition panel and as a trumpet teacher and ensemble coach. In May 2008 he was awarded an Honorary Associate of The Royal Academy of Music.

As well as continuing to work at Wells and as a freelance trumpet player and conductor, Paul is a busy composer and arranger having written music for television and radio. His brass arrangements and compositions have been performed and recorded by the country's leading ensembles. Paul was recently invited to set the new Guildhall School of Music Trumpet Syllabus and is in constant demand as an adjudicator, INSET trainer for music teachers and has written many articles for magazines such as *Classical Music*, *Early Music News*, *BBC Music Magazine*. He is also music critic for regional newspapers and magazines and regularly reviews new brass music for *Music Teacher Magazine*. Paul is married to Ruth and has four children. He has a deep passion for football and for many years has held a season ticket at Yeovil Town FC.
